Services that Pinal Alliance is Proposing and Benefit to the City of Eloy

Our program of services for FY 2020/2021 are reflective of the strategic structure designed by the board of directors to support Eloy and other community partners, including City of Casa Grande, City of Maricopa and Pinal County in a completely open and transparent manner. The City of Eloy has been a community partner of Pinal Alliance for Economic Growth, formerly Access Arizona and Central Arizona Regional Economic Development, for many years. To help accomplish Eloy's economic development objectives and to deliver results, Pinal Alliance proposes:

- Responding immediately to requests for support by the City of Eloy in the nimble manner only a private sector organization is capable. Pinal Alliance's staff and volunteer board and committee members are available to support the economic development and city management team at the City of Eloy to bolster the efforts of Eloy's staff.
- Responding on a timely basis to inquiries by site selection prospects by connecting those inquiring to the city's economic development professional directly.
- To work closely with strategic partners to address the workforce attraction and training challenges facing new and existing employers.
- Support the work of Achieve Pinal to connect the efforts of Achieve60AZ at the state level to Eloy. Pinal Alliance hosts the committee's website, achievecpinal.org, provides promotional materials, and markets its initiatives to help generate greater public and private awareness of the long-term steps needed in college entry and completion, adult education and training, and identifying and closing skills gaps to better prepare our workforce and our state for the future.
- Offer Achieve Pinal's Careertopia program to students in Eloy. The program teaches high school students the types of careers available to them and the education necessary.
- Assist the Achieve Pinal committee members in the launch of AARP Experience Corps Pinal-Casa Grande, which is a volunteer-based tutoring program that connects older adults to their communities by engaging them in the intergenerational work of helping young students become better readers. The program helps older adult volunteers maintain a sense of purpose by putting their wisdom to work, while at the same time addressing a major contributor to poverty: the inability of children to read at grade level by the end of third grade. Students who are unable to read at the end of the third grade are four times more likely to leave school without a diploma. The program's overarching goal is to develop a competitive workforce for current and future jobs. Our goal is to expand the program to other interested school districts in Pinal County in the third year of the program.
- Advocate for full funding of the I-10 Widening between Casa Grande and Chandler.
- Pursue inclusion of the City of Eloy in Pinal Alliance's association healthcare plan to reduce the cost associated with providing healthcare benefits to Eloy employees.
- Maintain a robust website with tools providing critical resources to support business attraction, retention and expansion efforts in the region. The website includes consistently updated demographic and economic data for the region.
- To provide the city with licensed access to Pinal Alliance's subscription to GIS Planning and EMSI's economic modeling programs, including nationwide data.
- Continue to market the advantages of Eloy internationally, nationally, statewide, regionally and locally as a place to locate or expand a business. Pinal Alliance is



budgeted to fund a social media professional, sponsorships and place advertisements on behalf of Eloy and its other community partners at a value of \$16,800 in FY 2020.

- Advocating on behalf of the community through the engagement on a pro-bono basis the firm of Dorn Policy Group to serve as Pinal Arizona's eyes and ears at the state legislature. The value of this representation is \$5,000 annually.

- Support the efforts of the City of Eloy and reach an audience of at least 1,000 community members in FY 2020/21. Audience will include senior citizens, elected leaders, chamber members, business leaders, high school students, and the education community.
- Impact community elected and business leaders with economic development messages through periodic forums/annual meeting. The goal will be to influence 250 leaders annually.
- The AARP Experience Corps Pinal-Casa Grande Reading Program will utilize seniors over 55 to tutor the program participants. It is expected the citizens of Eloy would be very interested in participating in this program.

Leveraged Resources

The partnership Pinal Alliance is proposing leverages the resources of all community partners and the board and committee members as volunteers. Our organizational model will positively impact Eloy's economic development efforts by leveraging, not duplicating, local efforts. The organization's board of directors is proud to come together at monthly meetings to consider how Pinal Alliance and each partner organization can work to improve the economic vitality of the region.

Over the past 10 years, SVC has developed, printed and introduced Self-guided Day(s) Trips to assist in the introduction of this area as well as other attractions around the State. Pinal County has more State Parks and National Monuments than any other county in Arizona. Eloy has the largest Sky-Dive Training Facility in the Country. Picacho Peak is a Civil War Site and is great for camping & hiking. Getting visitors excited about what there is to see brings them to our area for extended periods of time. And ultimately, some decide to rent or buy property. The popularity (and convenience) of the Day Trips has spread around Arizona, thanks to RV'ers taking time to stop and check out what our VC has to offer. Our trained Volunteers love to greet visitors and share information about what our area has to offer.

2. Benefit to the City of Eloy

The obvious benefit to The City of Eloy, is the gain in the economy as a result of the increase in visitation at Sunland Visitor Center. Area RV Parks, motels, gas stations, food businesses and retail stores gain business when cars pull off of a highway to check-out what there is to offer. A Visitor Center provides information on what there is to see, places to stay, where to eat, and where to shop for whatever. Tourists can be a very effective economic engine for a community. People spend more when they are on vacation.

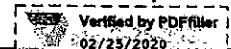

1. Brief Description of our services/program of work

We are the "Go To" Place for Eloy businesses, citizens & winter visitors to garner information on City Services, zoning requirements, local area businesses and tourist attractions. Our Business Memberships total 115, includes approximately 13 non-profit organizations. Once per year we provide local service organizations a venue to display their services and network with our membership at no cost. We plan to continue to provide a minimum of 6 business luncheons with relevant speakers, & 6 business mixers as well. We assist local citizens with City contacts & City services. We provide mailing packets for anyone interested in relocating to the Eloy Community. We sponsor the Memorial Day Ceremony, Eloy Memorial Park /Cemetery each year (85-110 attendees.) We recruit the keynote speaker and administer the role of master of ceremonies. Our CEO serves as the Vice Chair Commissioner on the Eloy Downtown Advisory Council, we work closely with the Eloy Economic Development Consultant and serve as well, on the Eloy Economic Development Committee.

We answer any citizen's request involving the community, city services and local tourism questions, 362 days a year.

2. Benefits to City of Eloy

We are the liaison for our business clients who need assistance & representation to take advantage of economic opportunities, & solve problems. Additionally, we work with the business community & citizens who need information on Eloy code & zoning issues, we have successfully provided the course of action to allow our businesses to gain approval on projects when they had no other recourse. Our CEO is Vice Chair of the Downtown Advisory Commission & actively involved. The Chamber's Tour of Empty buildings is held twice a year (Community Planning dept. is a partner,) we started with 11 vacant buildings and four have since been sold or occupied. We publish an annual Business Directory & Community Guide which is distributed to approximately 600 Citizens, 200 winter visitors and Chambers & Visitor Center offices throughout the state. We distribute @ 2,500 copies per year. We personally provide information on Eloy and our local Businesses to an average of 500 tourists/winter visitors per year. In this instance with the restrictions of the COVID-19, it has greatly hindered our organization's ability to plan our regular event. 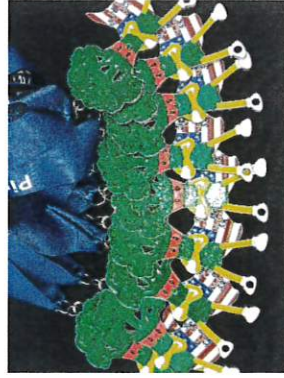
