Officer Patino administered Narcan to the victim and started CPR while Officer Gomez administered a second dose of Narcan and maintained an open airway until paramedics arrived. The victim was transported to the hospital where he recovered.

Mayor Powell led the Council and the public in the Pledge of Allegiance.

VI. REPORTS AND ANNOUNCEMENTS

A. Council Member Announcements

1. Councilmember Rodriguez made the following announcements:
 - Handed out the new business directory from the Eloy Chamber of Commerce. He said the directory is available to the public at the chamber office.
 - He recently attended the ASU Morrison Institute of Public Policy Summer Retreat. There was discussion on water and housing issues that communities are facing in Arizona. Councilmember Rodriguez pointed out that attending the retreat was at no cost to the city.
2. Vice Mayor Snyder gave a brief report on the Pinal Partnership monthly breakfast. Topic of discussion at the breakfast meeting was water.

B. Mayor's Announcements

Mayor Powell made the following announcements:

- There was a comment made at the last meeting that he was a “coward” for not attending the meeting. He wanted to clarify that he did not attend the last meeting because he and his family was on vacation that had been planned since May. Mayor Powell said he makes every effort to attend every meeting and that it is disheartening to hear a member of the public making such a comment.
- Congratulated Michelle McKinley-Tarango, Jose Garcia, and Andrew Rodriguez on their win for Council.
- Attended the Casa Grande Chamber of Commerce ribbon cutting ceremony August 18th for CoreCivic’s new career center. After the ribbon cutting, he visited the detention facility and met international motivation speaker, Mr. Byron Warren. Mayor Powell said the words that Mr. Warren spoke to some of the inmates and to him were uplifting and impactful. He said he invited Mr. Warren back to Eloy to tour the city.
- Several members of the Council and city staff will be attending the League of Arizona Cities and Towns annual conference in Glendale. Mayor Powell said he was invited and would like to invite other Councilmembers who will be attending the conference to a roundtable luncheon sponsored by Congressman Tom O’Halloran. The luncheon will be on Wednesday.
- Recent rainstorms have generated a lot of weeds in the city. He asked the public and city staff to please be patient with the city and the residents clearing weeds off their properties.
- The new Circle K is now open. Mayor Powell stated that the new store stems from a convention that he and several members of the Council attended a few years back.

- Skydive Arizona will be hosting the U.S. Parachute Association World Championship on October 8-27, 2022 at the Eloy airport. Mayor Powell said at the last event, 16 countries were represented; this year there will be 30 countries.
- The Planning and Zoning Commission approved a preliminary plat of Vista de Picacho last week, which is a 365-lot single family subdivision.

C. City Manager's Announcements

Quarterly Fiscal Report Ending June 30, 2022 - Mr. Wright gave a brief visual overview of the quarterly report.

Mr. Malewitz provided the following communications to Council and the public:

- City offices will be closed on Monday, September 5th, in observance of the Labor Day holiday.
- The city will be hosting a flu and vaccination clinic on Wednesday, September 14th, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at city hall. The clinic is open to the public and no appointment is necessary.
- New trash rates for the customers will go in effect on Thursday, September 1st.
- Provided Council with a report from Pinal County Animal Control last week on the monthly status of animals captures in Eloy. Mr. Malewitz said the July reports shows the city paid county animal control \$6,699.00 for services. There were 37 calls for service; 20 cats captured (2 adopted, 10 fostered); and 19 dogs captured (5 fostered, 3 returned to owners). He said no dogs were euthanized.
- He hired Mr. Kazi Haque as the city's new assistant city manager. Mr. Malewitz said Mr. Haque comes from Yavapai County having previously worked for the City of Maricopa. Mr. Haque has a wealth of experience with community development and growth and helped spearhead a lot of the growth in Maricopa. Mr. Haque is scheduled to start his employment with the city September 6th.

There being no requests from the Council to remove any item(s) from the Consent Agenda, Mayor Powell called for a motion.

Motion by Councilmember Garcia, seconded by Councilmember Guanajuato Rodriguez to approve the Consent Agenda items as presented, passed unanimously by roll call vote (5-0).

VIII. BUSINESS

A. COUNCIL TO APPROVE AN ADDITIONAL EX-OFFICIO POSITION TO SERVE AS A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE ELOY CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, ACTING IN THE CAPACITY OF A NON-VOTING MEMBER, ON THE REVITALIZATION COMMISSION.

Staff Cover Sheet Report: *Staff recommends creating a non-voting Ex-Officio position to serve on the Eloy Revitalization Commission. The Revitalization Commission has formally recommended that this Ex-Officio position be filled by the presiding President of the Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors or his/her designee. Due to the fact that many of the topics, issues and projects considered by the Commission have a direct or indirect impact on the City's small businesses as well as those areas of the community that are, or will be, populated by small businesses, the Commission and Staff believe that this appointment will allow for*

enhanced coordination between these two important bodies in the City. Key areas where this coordination is critical include the Downtown area, Frontier Street and several other emerging areas of the City. Adding a seat on the Commission to represent the Chamber of Commerce (as a non-voting member) will enhance the Commission's success by actively including the timely input of the Chamber in the deliberation of direction and proposed new development, redevelopment, or revitalization projects.

Over the initial seven months of recently updated and revised Revitalization Commission meetings, it has become very apparent that, through the many topics discussed and projects undertaken by the Commission, they would benefit from the input and participation by the Eloy Chamber of Commerce. Approval of this request will allow for enhanced communication and coordination between the City and the Chamber, resulting in an expanded level of opportunity for mutual success in the City's revitalization and redevelopment efforts. Providing a seat at the Commission's table for the Chamber will create a stronger partnership between the public and private sectors of our community.

FISCAL IMPACT: *Approval of this request will not result in a cost or financial burden to the City of Eloy.*

Mr. Vlaming conveyed that discussions and dialogs at the Revitalization Commission meetings over the past eight months have been reflective of the downtown area. He said it came to staff's attention that it would be beneficial to have some representation from the Eloy Chamber of Commerce in an ex-officio capacity to serve on the Revitalization Commission. Mr. Vlaming said staff is requesting the Council consider selecting a person from the Chamber Board of Directors or the Executive Director to serve as a conduit between the Chamber and the Revitalization Commission.

Councilmember Rodriguez asked Mr. Cooper if he should recuse himself from discussion and voting on this item because he serves as executive director of the Eloy Chamber of Commerce.

Mr. Cooper explained to Councilmember Rodriguez that the appointment does not involve any economic consideration to him and therefore, is not considered a conflict of interest.

Mayor Powell wanted it on the record that Vice Mayor Snyder serves on the Eloy Chamber of Commerce as a board member and is also the Council ex-officio to the Revitalization Commission.

Councilmember Guanajuato Rodriguez stated that she serves as Council ex-officio on the Chamber Board of Directors.

Vice Mayor Snyder said that he would prefer that the president of the Chamber Board of Directors or his/her designee serve as ex-officio.

There being no further comments, Mayor Powell called for a motion.

Motion by Vice Mayor Snyder, seconded by Councilmember Rodriguez to approve appointing the presiding Eloy Chamber of Commerce board president or his/her designee as additional ex-officio to serve as a representative, acting in the capacity of a non-voting member, on the Revitalization Commission, passed unanimously by roll call vote (5-0).

B. ADOPTION OF RESOLUTION NO. 22-1536 ACCEPTING A RECOMMENDATION FROM THE ELOY HOUSING AUTHORITY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS APPROVING THE DISSOLUTION OF THE ELOY HOUSING AUTHORITY AND THE TRANSFER OF ALL PROGRAM-RELATED BUSINESS TO THE PINAL COUNTY HOUSING AUTHORITY EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 31, 2022.

Staff Cover Sheet Report: *The City of Eloy created the Housing Authority in 1965 pursuant to the Municipal Housing Law of Arizona. In 2010, HUD declared the Housing Authority officially "troubled", and the City's Mayor and Council served as the Interim Board of Commissioners. A private management firm was hired in 2010 and has managed the Authority since that time, converting all public housing units under the Section 18 and RAD (Rental Assistance Demonstration) programs. The private management firm intends to end its agreement with the Authority for the management of the Eloy Public Housing Program, and jointly managed Maddox Estates through a Housing Choice Voucher Program. After discussions with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and the Board of Commissioners for the Eloy Housing Authority, the Board has determined it is in the best interest of the City of Eloy, its citizens, and the participants of the Housing Authority programs to dissolve the Eloy Housing Authority and transfer the Voucher Program to Pinal County Housing Authority on December 31, 2022.*

At this time, the following items are planned to be part of the transfer to the Pinal County Housing Authority upon the dissolution of the public housing program in the City of Eloy:

- 1. Eloy Housing Authority Administrative Offices at 100 W. Phoenix Ave. in Eloy. HUD appraisal value of \$364,000.*
- 2. Capital fund grants in the amount of \$177,072. All funds are solely dedicated to City of Eloy projects only.*

Separately, for City Council consideration is the purchase of the Eloy Housing Authority Administrative Offices at 100 W. Phoenix Ave. in Eloy. Under HUD guidelines and rules, the City of Eloy has the option to purchase the administrative

building for fair market value from HUD during the dissolution period. All monies from the purchase of the building will be allocated towards the housing program for the City of Eloy and administered by Pinal County Housing Authority. In March 2022, the building was appraised for \$364,300 in an appraisal contracted through the Eloy Housing Authority. The City of Eloy independently had an appraisal performed in August 2022 with a reported valuation of \$210,000. Under HUD rules, the purchase price is the average difference between the two independent appraisals. In this case, if the city desires to purchase the building, the cost would be \$287,150.

FISCAL IMPACT: *None. Unless a majority vote by City Council is made to purchase the Eloy Housing Authority Administrative Offices located at 100 W. Phoenix Ave. in downtown Eloy.*

Mr. Malewitz conveyed that the proposed resolution, if approved would dissolve the Eloy Housing Authority and transfer all assets related to the authority to the Pinal County Housing Authority for administration of the Eloy Section 8 Housing and Voucher program, effective January 1, 2023.

Mayor Powell disclosed for the record that he serves as chairman on the Eloy Housing Authority Board. He also disclosed that Councilmember Rodriguez also serves on the Board. He recognized EHA vice chair, Mr. Steve Falek and the EHA attorney, Ms. Harvey as being in attendance tonight.

Mayor Powell conveyed that the EHA and the city are two separate entities and not associated with each other.

Mr. Falek conveyed that the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for some time have been trying to get itself out of the ownership business in terms of public housing. He said HUD has transferred all of the public housing assets through a special program, a rent assistance demonstration program, so that all future housing would be through private landlords through the Section 8 program. Mr. Falek said the other issue that caused the Board to come to the decision of dissolving the EHA was the Council became involved in the administration of the EHA a number of years ago, when it was designated as a troubled agency under HUD guidelines. He said Cindy Herrera and Associates, a housing authority managing firm, was hired to run the Eloy Housing Authority and through their work brought the housing authority to “high performer” status under HUD’s evaluation program. Mr. Falek stated that this action is not about the performance of the housing authority or the Board. It is about policy making at the federal level and what that impact is at the local level.

Mayor Powell stated that the Eloy Housing Authority’s voucher program would be transferred to Pinal County, who has more resources and staff. Upon approval by Pinal County, funds (approximately \$177,000) would be transferred to Pinal County and dedicated exclusively to Eloy residents. Mayor Powell said HUD is giving the city until December 31, 2022 to complete the transfer. He pointed out that Mr.

Malewitz has been working with Herrera and Associates and the Eloy Housing Authority legal team to make the transition. Mayor Powell stated that Ms. Herrera's contract with the housing authority expires at the end of the year and expressed her desire to not continue with her services. Mayor Powell said the Board is still in discussion about the 22 housing units and the housing authority building. He pointed out that doing this is not taking anything away from the residents but adding more benefits for the residents of Eloy who utilize this program.

Mr. Falek recommended that the Council require regular reports from Pinal County on how the Section 8 voucher program is being utilized in Eloy.

Mr. Malewitz conveyed that Pinal County will continue to lease the housing authority administration building to the city. He said the police department has been utilizing part of the building for storage of equipment and firearms simulation program. Mr. Malewitz voiced that the city has the funds to purchase the building, however there is a mold issue that Pinal County and HUD is aware of. This has to be addressed and remediated. In the process of that, it puts the city outside of its timeline of having to purchase the building. The housing authority will still be responsible for performing mold testing to determine the extent of the damage and what remediation cost would be needed to ensure that the building is safe. Mr. Malewitz said the building is part of the asset package that would be transferred to Pinal County at the end of the year. He said at this time the city is in a holding pattern. The city needs to know what is going on with the mold and what is happening with remediation. He said the Council will then proceed with the potential purchase of the building, if that is the wish of the Council. Mr. Malewitz said money has been allocated through the general fund contingency and the police department will allocate monies through their marijuana resource recovery program to help pay for a loan that would support the city purchasing the building.

Vice Mayor Snyder wanted to know if assurances that the money from Eloy would be dedicated solely to Eloy residents and reports from Pinal County on how the funds are being used be included in the contract with Pinal County.

Mayor Powell said the resolution that he signed last week as chairman of the housing authority, includes a provision about the funds being used for Eloy residents only.

Mr. Malewitz conveyed that he will be meeting with deputy county manager, Himanshu Patel, next week to discuss the details of the transfer and contract.

Councilmember Garcia said he understands that some units that were sold a couple of years ago were sold at a higher price than this. He asked what happened in that two-year timeframe.

Mr. Falek conveyed as part of HUD getting out of the ownership of property, the housing authority had to de-program 24 of its units, via a competitive bidding

process. He said the units were sold to a developer, who is building new units and renting them through the Section 8 program.

Councilmember Garcia asked how much the developer paid for the units.

Mr. Falek said he does not know the exact number, but the units were sold at market rate.

Mayor Powell said he believes the units sold for around \$300,000. He believes the money has to use the money for maintenance and upkeep of the other units. Mayor Powell said the 24 units were sold approximately five years ago.

Mr. Malewitz had a copy of the resolution from the housing authority that Mayor Powell signed as chairman of the Housing Authority Board last week. It specifically states in the last paragraph that the money transferred from the Eloy Housing Authority to Pinal County Housing is to be used exclusively in the public housing units located in the City of Eloy. The resolution also states that the city is to continue leasing the administrative building. Mr. Malewitz said tonight's resolution that is before Council echoes the same provisions. He said Pinal County would also need to pass a resolution agreeing to the terms and conditions in order to move forward with the transfer.

There being no further comments or questions, Mayor Powell called for a motion to read the resolution by title only.

A motion was made by Councilmember Rodriguez and seconded by Councilmember Garcia, to read Resolution No. 22-1536 by title only, passed unanimously (5-0).

The city clerk read the resolution title into the record.

Mayor Powell called for a motion to adopt the resolution.

Motion by Councilmember Guanajuato Rodriguez, seconded by Vice Mayor Snyder to adopt Resolution No. 22-1536 as presented, passed 4-1 by the following roll call vote:

RECOMMENDATION:

it is recommended for the Council to approve the purchase of firearm ammunition for the Police Department. This proposed ammunition purchase includes both training ammunition used for general firearms training and qualifications and ammunition used for duty use. Training ammunition is generally designed as basic ammunition suitable for firing at paper and steel targets. Duty ammunition is a higher quality product that is designed for high levels of performance and terminal ballistics.

DISCUSSION:

The Eloy Police Department requests permission to proceed with the annual procurement of firearms training and duty ammunition. This procurement request is for 35,000 rounds of .223 caliber ammunition, and 35,000 rounds of 9mm ammunition for ongoing firearms and tactical training. This portion of the request is for training ammunition that is suitable for firearms range drills and qualifications. This purchase allocates 1,000 rounds of training ammunition for each sworn member of the Department for both rifle and handgun training courses to be presented throughout the fiscal year, as well as, additional firearms-related courses officers may attend. This procurement request also includes higher quality duty ammunition that the officers will carry while on duty in both rifles and handguns. With last fiscal year's purchase of all new weapons systems, this purchase will facilitate the training needed to maintain a very critical and parishable skill.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The fiscal impact of this purchase is \$25,159.75. This procurement was programed into the FY 22/23 budget for Police Field Supplies.

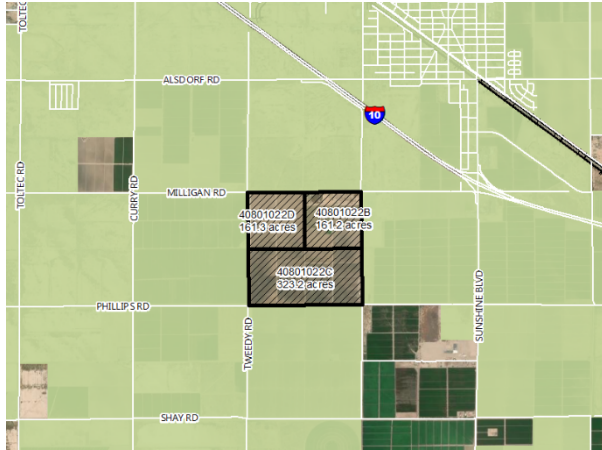
RECOMMENDATION:

Council authorize Staff to initiate annexation proceedings on parcels 408-01-022B, 408-01-022C and 408-01-022D and thier adjacent rights of way within Section 13, Township 8 South, Range 7 East, of the Gila and Salt River Base and Meridian, Pinal County, Arizona.

DISCUSSION:

This is a request by 301AK 8me LLC who received written authorization from MDT Investments LTD Partnership, the property owner, to annex approximately 645.7 acres of land comprised of three Pinal County Assessor's Parcel Numbers: 408-01-022B, 408-01-022C and 408-01-022D in Section 13, T.8 S., R. 7 E. into the City of Eloy. The subject parcels are currently within a "county island" which is bounded on all four sides by the City of Eloy.

Annexation is the process by which a city may assume jurisdiction over unincorporated territory adjacent to its incorporated boundaries. As such, annexation represents a significant step in the overall growth of a city. In Arizona, annexation requires the consent of the **owners of at least one-half of the value** of the real and personal property and the consent of **more than one-half of the number of property owners** in the territory to be annexed as documented by the latest county assessor data. In this case, the area to be annexed is held by one owner. Completed petitions must be filed with the County Recorder within one year after the last day of the thirty-day waiting period. In addition, the consent and action of the city council are required.



The three parcels are currently held by one ownership entity and are under agricultural production. The existing zoning on all three subject parcels (as per Pinal County) is General Rural (GR), which allows one residential dwelling unit per 1.25 acres of land. If successfully annexed, this property would be designated as R1-54 (one residential dwelling unit per 54,450 square feet (1.25 acres) as the translational zoning into the City of Eloy. The Eloy General Plan identifies Section 13 as Estate Density Residential/0.2-1.0 du/ac for approximately 480 acres and Medium Density Residential/3-6 du/ac for approximately 160 acres. The property owners' intent is to annex the property and entitle it to allow for long term (estimated at 20-30 years) solar generation use.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The fiscal impact of this annexation would increase the incorporated area of the City, which would then be subject to enhanced services to maintain perimeter roads and police protection at this time. However, because the subject property is bounded on all four sides by the City, and the city's current boundary extends approximately five miles to the south, these costs would be minimal.

If the property is developed as requested by the property owner (solar generation), the improvements to the land would translate to higher property taxes accruing to the city as well as the applicable construction sales tax as a result of the construction of the solar arrays and other related improvements to the property.

Introduction

This request proposes an annexation of the following three parcels (hereafter referred to as the “Site”) encompassing Section 13 in unincorporated Pinal County, Arizona into the City of Eloy:

The 640-acre Site is bounded on the north by West Milligan Road, on the east by Eleven Mile Corner Road, on the south by East Phillips Road, and on the west by South Tweedy Road. The Site is identified by the Pinal County Assessor's Parcel Numbers listed in Table 1 above, and in the attached EXHIBIT B, Legal Description of Property. The parcels are currently vacant and are in unincorporated Pinal County, Arizona.

Site Details

The Property Owner, MDT Investments LTD Partnership, has executed a Memorandum of Solar Generating Facility Land Option and Lease Agreement with 301AK 8me LLC and provided authorization to 301AK 8me LLC to annex the three parcels in Section 13 into the City of Eloy. The Site is bounded on all four sides by the City of Eloy and is surrounded by hundreds of acres of unimproved land.

Pinal County's Comprehensive Plan currently designates the Site as Very Low Density Residential (0-1 du/acres) with General Rural (GR) zoning, and it is currently shown as Estate Residential in Eloy's General Plan. Once the Site is annexed into Eloy, 301AK 8me LLC will file the appropriate entitlement applications to allow for the development of a solar photovoltaic generation facility, substation, gen-tie line, and battery energy storage system.

Conclusion

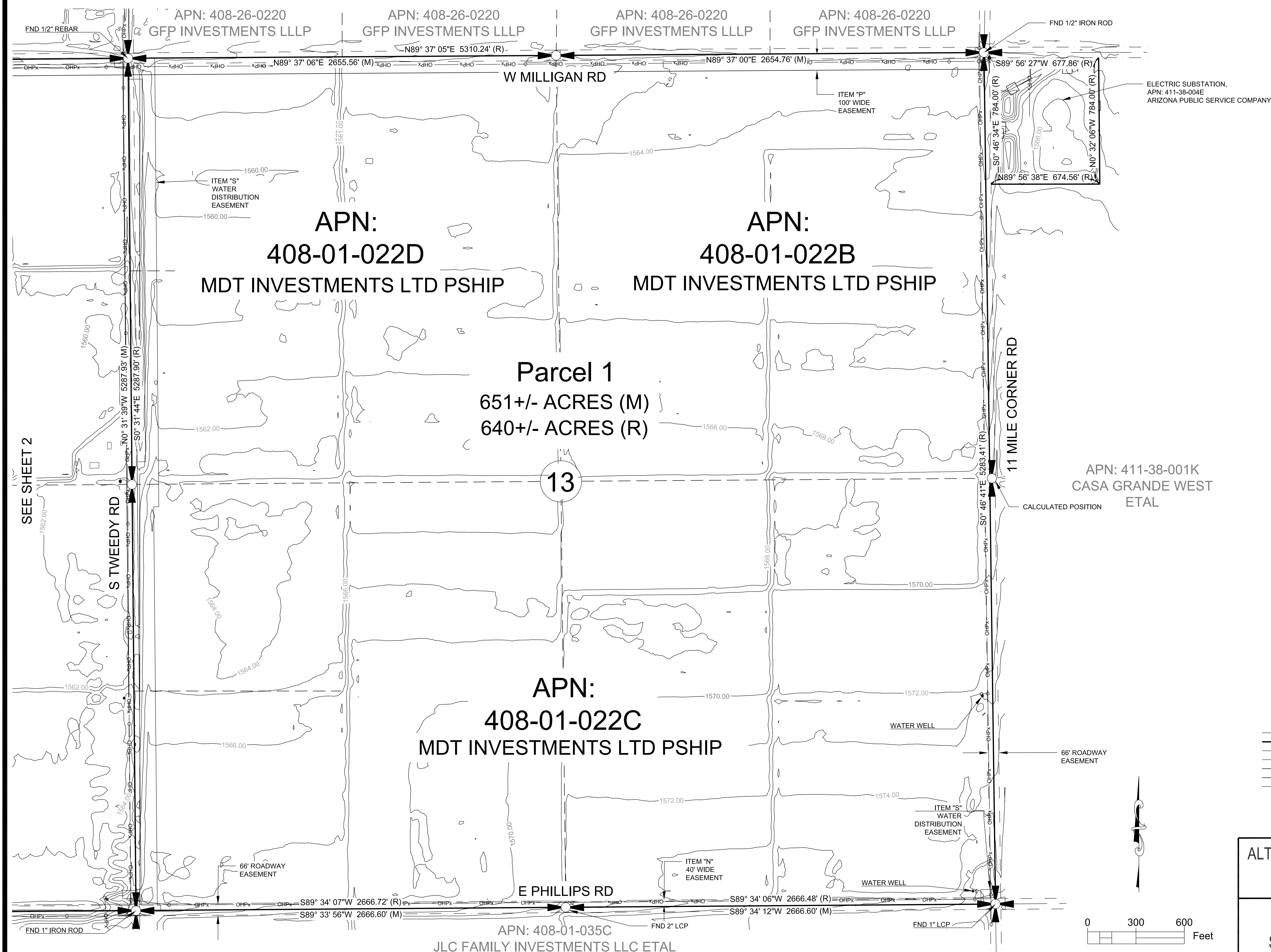
The Site is currently a “county island” surrounded by Eloy, so annexing it into the city is a reasonable request. As mentioned, the Owner has executed a Memorandum of Solar Generating Facility Land Option and Lease Agreement with 301AK 8me LLC and provided authorization to annex the land. There would be no negative impacts on Eloy's public utilities by annexing the Site into the city. The future solar use will have no burden on public services such as water and sewer but will, in fact, provide renewable green energy to the area and to the state. This project will be an asset to the City of Eloy and allow the city to grow and raise significant tax revenue in a manner that is consistent with the goals and policies of the City of Eloy General Plan.

Furthermore, this annexation request will conform to the requirements and procedures as outlined in Arizona Revised Statutes Section 9-471. The petitioning process will begin following the confirmation of acceptance of this request.

DISCUSSION:

The Eloy Police Department requests permission to accept a proposal from Goserco, Inc., to purchase a new Eventide 740 DX recording system. The State of Arizona is transitioning to Next Generation 911, with a cutover expected for Eloy PD in mid-October. With Next Generation 911 comes expanded communications capabilities, which include features like text-to-911 and video chat.

In addition to Next Generation 911, the Department is in the process of transitioning from its current VHF radio system to a digital, encrypted 800mhz system on the Pinal Regional Communications Consortium. The new Eventide 740 DX system will provide the capacity needed to ensure continuous recording of these new digital radio channels. The cutover to the new radio system is expected to occur before the end of the calendar year.

Other features of the new Eventide 740 DX system include screen recording, quality assurance/quality factor for evaluating dispatcher performance on calls, Vesta IP position recording to integrate with the new Vesta 911 systems, Geofence search capability, and RapidSOS Integration. This system replaces the current recording machine used since approximately 2016. As the Department's communications capabilities continue to expand, it is important to be prepared with the appropriate recording systems in place. Law enforcement communications are public records, and the Department is required to retain them under the law.

This proposal includes one year of maintenance from the date of installation. The

estimated cost of maintenance for future fiscal years is approximately \$9,619.50 per year, beginning in fiscal year 2023-2024. The Department will request funds in its maintenance/operating budget as needed to cover the costs associated with the maintenance plan for this system.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Goserco has provided the Eloy Police Department pricing per General Services Administration (GSA) contract # GS-35F-0415V. The fiscal impact of this proposal is \$62,198.73. This project is included in the Eloy Police Department's fiscal year 2022-2023 Capital Improvement Plan project list, and \$70,000.00 is budgeted for a new recording system.

Statement of Work (SOW) and Statement of Purpose

Goserco, Inc. is pleased to submit this statement of work to ELOY POLICE DEPARTMENT for services to deliver: the applicable installation, configuration, testing, training, and the relevant project management, for a new or upgrade communications recording solution. This document outlines, the services that Goserco, Inc. will provide, as well as those expected to be provided by ELOY POLICE DEPARTMENT, or its relevant vendors, in planning for and implementing this project. It may also describe specific services to be customized to your environment. Specifically, this SOW is only for the applicable installation, configuration, testing, training, and the relevant project management, for a communications recording solution.

In the event of overlap, any specific terms and conditions agreed to by Goserco by other device (contract, RFP response, or other written agreement) shall take precedence over this statement of work. With authorized signature by both parties, and in the absence of such an outside agreement, the terms and conditions specified in this statement of work shall apply, and constitute agreement to such terms and conditions by both parties.

Changes to this Statement of Work will be processed in accordance with the procedures described in "Appendix B. Project Change Control Procedure". A Change Authorization must be approved and accepted by both parties to initiate scope changes under this agreement. The investigation and the implementation of changes may result in modifications to any aspect of the project schedule, pricing/invoiced charges, and/or other terms of this agreement. Without signatures of acceptance, specific pricing (if any) in this Statement of Work expires 60 days following the date of its preparation.

Project Scope

The scope – the customized and detailed list of specific items that define what will be considered "in-scope" for this project, is written in a separate section that follows titled, "Project Scope Detail". The Project Scope Detail is considered part of this statement of work.

Assumptions

General

- The customer will provide a single point of contact that will act as the project owner and who will be the primary individual to sign off on the project phases at completion
- All work under this statement of work will occur Monday-Friday between the hours of 8:00 am and 5:00 pm; no installations, configuration, moves, site visits, or other related work will be scheduled over weekends, evenings, or Goserco, Inc.-declared holidays, without mutual agreement in advance from the Goserco, Inc. project manager and the customer project manager

- Goserco, Inc. and the customer will jointly create any project documentation, where customer involvement is required. The customer must approve the final installation schedule and final versions of project documentation to ensure it coincides with all expectations
- Goserco, Inc. and the customer will jointly create any special requirements for defining “project acceptance” in writing, and with mutual agreement to such requirements, those requirements will become part of a written cutover plan (or installation checklist)
- “Project acceptance” (via a signed installation service ticket or other written acknowledgement) should follow (within 24 hours) completion of the written project plan, and a successful support turnover call, and Goserco’s delivery to the customer of “as-built” system configuration documentation

Premises Work

- The customer will be responsible for all carpentry or mechanical work not explicitly detailed in this proposal
- The customer location does not require the use of union labor
- The customer assumes all responsibility for compliance with local and federal laws and regulations as they relate to recording telephone, radio, and other electronic or audio conversations, as well as other electronic communications (including visual) such as desktop screen recording and application usage tracking, etc.

Specific Technical Services and Other Provisions

Equipment-Environment

- Customer will ensure adequate UPS power and power distribution for all servers to be installed
- Customer will ensure adequate rack mounting space and proper environmental control where any equipment is to be installed - standard 19" 4-post rack rail hardware is typically supplied with new systems purchased from Goserco, Inc., however in cases where the standard supplied rack rail hardware will not accommodate a proper installation, the customer will provide and install suitable rack shelving or other mounting hardware as may be required by local building/equipment installation codes

- An appropriate customer network technician will be on-hand and available (on installation and testing days) to assist with installation and client software installation as needed, as well as produce client software load procedure documentation in conjunction with a Goserco, Inc. technician at the installation
- All network configuration required to produce a successful implementation is the responsibility of the customer, and will be provided to Goserco, Inc. free of charge. A successful implementation includes both server connectivity and client pc network connectivity and configuration. Additionally, it is the responsibility of the customer to provide and ensure LAN/WAN connectivity and configuration that will allow for proper client access from within, or off-site, if applicable (including firewall configuration where necessary)
- Customer will provide a list of client pc's, AD user names, actual user names, and a seating chart (to include desired channel-level security restrictions) if Goserco, Inc. is to perform any installation of client software and restrict access to the system on a per-user basis

Telephone/PBX, Radio System, and or IP Dispatch Console Integration and Requested Configuration Information

- For integrated recording of any telephone/PBX, digital radio, or IP dispatch console communications system, the customer will provide or otherwise arrange for purchase, installation, and configuration of all telephone/PBX, digital radio, and or IP dispatch console hardware and software (including any required licensing that may be necessary to support recording in the customer environment). The customer will provide or otherwise arrange for purchase, installation, and configuration of any and all related/required network infrastructure (such as switches, firewalls, communications circuits, etc.). The customer will provide or otherwise arrange for purchase of all telephone/PBX, digital radio, and or IP dispatch console configuration, testing, and troubleshooting services, as well as any required network configuration (including SPAN ports if required), testing, and troubleshooting necessary to establish or support proper recording connectivity and communications to the telephone/PBX, digital radio, and or IP dispatch consoles, and the customer network
- Customer will provide a complete list of requested telephone/PBX, digital radio, and or IP dispatch console information: including, but not limited to, hardware and software versions, IP addresses, protocols, etc. as well as details that may be needed to ensure a successful integration and proper recording such as: agents, extensions, device identifying information, channels, talk groups, and frequency ID's and or names, etc.

Wiring

Traditional Device Monitoring, and Other Wiring Notes

- In general, Goserco, Inc. will provide a demarcation point (typically 1 or more 66 blocks) and cable connection from this demarcation point to the recorder(s). The customer is responsible to provide feed wiring for any and all audio sources to be recorded, and cross-connect to the provided demarcation point
- For direct digital station tapping, the customer is responsible to provide feed wiring for any extension to be recorded. This is typically accomplished (for supported handset models), by passing the cross-connect wiring from the designated PBX output pair, through the provided recording demarcation point (punch without cut/termination), and on to the designated premise wiring/jack pair for the phone to be recorded. Goserco will re-cross connect existing phones so that they pass through the recording demark in cases where the customer can identify all phones to be recorded (e.g. produce a list of devices required to

be recorded) and identify and mark existing extension punch down locations for at least one side of the existing cross connects of phones to be recorded (PBX port pair, or premise wiring pair)

- For analog recording (full-time or record-on-demand) of digital or VoIP phones via logger patch, analog feed wiring in the form of a CAT5 cable home run from within 5' of phone (terminated as an RJ11), to recorder demarcation block (non-terminated) is to be provided to Goserco, Inc. at no charge for each phone to be recorded. Goserco, Inc. will typically provide and install the required analog logger patches – note: a standard 110V AC power outlet within 5' of the phone is also required
- Intrado/Positron: For analog recording of LIFELINE100 and VIPER systems, CCB/SONIC analog feed wiring for position audio and E911 CAMA trunks (if applicable) is to be provided to Goserco, Inc. at no charge. If ANI/ALI integration is included, a standard DB9M serial connector (providing standard CDR from the Viper system) is required, and will be provided to Goserco, Inc. at no charge.
- Airbus/Cassidian: For analog recording of VESTA and systems, ACU/SAM analog feed wiring for position audio and E911 CAMA trunks (if applicable) is to be provided to Goserco, Inc. at no charge. If ANI/ALI integration is included, a standard DB9M serial connector (providing the ANI/ALI CAD spill) is required, and will be provided to Goserco, Inc. at no charge.
- For analog recording of radio, the customer is responsible to provide feed wiring that provides combined transmit/receive audio for any channel, frequency, or console to be recorded to Goserco, Inc. at no charge
- Signal strength (when audio is present) for analog VOX recording is typically optimal for recording in a range of -10dBm to 0dBm

The installation checklist/cutover plan document will also provide a brief outline/timeline of expected activities for on-site time, and will require customer approval prior to installation. Unless otherwise agreed and indicated on documentation provided by Goserco, Inc. to you, such as an invoice, or otherwise provided herein, you will pay all shipping costs for Equipment, Product or Licensed Software you purchase from Goserco, Inc. In the event you dispute any amount on an invoice, you must provide written notification of the dispute to Goserco, Inc. within ten (10) days after you receive the disputed invoice. Goserco, Inc. agrees to provide supporting documentation concerning any disputed amount or invoice within ten (10) days after written notification of the dispute to Goserco, Inc. Both parties agree to use their best efforts to resolve such dispute within thirty (30) days after you provide written notification of the dispute. You shall have no obligation during the thirty (30) day period specified above to pay any amount that you reasonably dispute hereunder, but you agree to pay the undisputed portion of the invoice.

Shipping; Risk of Loss

All risk of loss or damage to the Products shall be the responsibility of the party upon whose premises the Products are located at the time of such loss or damage. Each party further agrees not to employ any former employee of the other party unless the employer-employee relationship has been terminated for not less than one hundred eighty (180) days. In the event of breach of this provision by a party or any Related Entities, such party shall be liable to the other party for the principal sum of Twenty Five Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$25,000.00) as liquidated damages, and not as a penalty for said breach.

Confidentiality

All documentation and information which are either designated as confidential or proprietary or would reasonably be considered to be confidential or proprietary, including without limitation, drawings, listings, techniques, algorithms, processes and technical and marketing information, business data and employee information which are transferred between the parties in connection with this agreement ("Proprietary Information") (other than documentation and information intended for general distribution to third parties) shall be held in strict confidence by the parties, and shall not be disclosed or used in any fashion other than pursuant to the terms of this agreement without the other party's prior written consent. Each party's proprietary information and all other items related thereto, including, without limitation, programs, methods of processing, specific design and structure of individual programs and their interaction, and the unique programming techniques employed therein, and all enhancements, modifications, updates, and derivative works thereof are and shall remain the sole and exclusive property of such party and shall not be sold, revealed, used, disclosed, transmitted or otherwise communicated, directly or indirectly, by the other party except as expressly provided for in this Agreement. Each party agrees to protect the others' proprietary Information with the same standard of care and procedures that it uses to protect its own trade secrets and Proprietary Information of a confidential nature.

Force Majeure

Neither party shall be deemed to be in default or to have breached any provision of this Agreement as a result of any delay, failure in performance or interruption of service resulting directly or indirectly from acts due to events of nature, acts of civil or military

authorities, civil disturbances, wars, strikes or other labor disputes, fires, transportation contingencies, laws, regulations, acts or orders of any government or agency or officials thereof, other catastrophes or any other similar occurrences beyond such party's reasonable control. In every case, the delay or failure in performance or interruption of service must be without fault or negligence of the party claiming excusable delay and the party claiming excusable delay must promptly notify the other party of such delay. Performance time under this Agreement shall be considered extended for a period of time equivalent to the time lost because of any delay, which is excusable under this paragraph, provided, however, that if any such delay continues for a period of more than sixty (60) days, the party not claiming excusable delay shall have the option of terminating the order or service upon written notice to the party claiming excusable delay

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval to enter into an agreement with Biddle & Brown Fence Company for the purchase and installation of one F-1 solar swing gate operator with concrete pads at Eloy Memorial Park.

DISCUSSION:

On January 5, 2022, the Eloy Cemetery Committee voted to close the cemetery's entry gates on a nightly basis due to continued vandalism at Eloy Memorial Park. The Park's visitation hours are Monday through Sunday, from sunset to sunrise. Currently, the park's entry gates are opened Monday through Friday at Sunrise by the city's Community Services Park's staff, with assistance in securing the gates in the evenings from the Eloy Police Department. The gates are opened on the weekends by a volunteer member of the Cemetery Committee. The installation of an automatic gate opener will provide a more efficient method of closing the cemetery gates at the designated time, therefore decreasing the potential risk of theft and vandalism on the cemetery grounds.

The F-1 Swing Gate Operator includes the V-Flex control board and a removable power supply box for low voltage wiring. The gate operator's steel chassis allows increased handling for gates up to 1500 lbs. The proposed agreement includes labor and materials to raise the existing gate and add solar swing gate operators on concrete pads. The swing gate system carries a 120-watt solar kit, EMX infrared through-beam photo eye kit, digital timer, and wireless keypad.

It is recommended that the City approve the contract with Biddle & Brown Fence Company in the amount of twenty-nine thousand, four hundred eighty-six dollars and forty-three cents (**\$29, 486.43**).

The purchase can be made through the **1 Government Procurement Alliance** (1GPA), contract **#22-12P**. The 1GPA purchasing cooperative allows public entities to

take advantage of existing contracts to purchase the goods and services needed from local and national vendors. 1GPA Contracts are approved and awarded by 1GPA's lead governmental entities and are available for use and benefit of all entities complying with their own state procurement laws and regulations. All contracts are competitively bid and awarded in compliance with state statutes, procurement laws and regulations.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Funding is available in the City's Capital Improvement fund in the amount of **thirty thousand dollars** (\$30,000) and was approved by City Council through the 22/23 budget process. The Finance Director concurs with this recommendation.

DISCUSSION:

As required by ARS 9-463.05, the City Manager or designee shall submit the Development Impact Fee Annual Report to the Mayor and Council within 90 days of the end of the fiscal year.

During the fiscal year 2021-2022, the City collected 145 impact fees for Parks and Recreation, 362 for Police, and 145 for Streets for a total collection of Development Impact Fees of \$719,157 while collecting interest revenue of \$556.05. During this same period, the City of Eloy used \$0.00 for related expenses.

Finally, no development impact fee revenues were used to repay either bonds issued by the City or to pay for the cost of a capital improvement project that is subject to a development impact fee assessment or monies advanced by the city from funds other than the funds established for development impact fees in order to pay the cost of a capital improvement project that is the subject of a development impact fee assessment.

INTRODUCTION

This report is designed to fulfill the requirements of the Arizona Revised Statutes (ARS). Section 9-463.05 (N). It contains information concerning the City of Eloy's collection and use of development fees. The information contained in this report is based on the City's fund financial statements, but it is unaudited data.

The annual report must be submitted to the City Clerk and posted on the City's Web site within 90 days following the end of the fiscal year. If the report is not submitted and posted within 90 days, the City cannot collect development impact fees until the report is submitted and posted. ARS refers to the fees as "development fees"; the City refers to them as "development fees."

TischlerBise performed an updated Land Use Assumptions, Infrastructure Improvements Plan, and Development Fee Report in January 2020. The Eloy City Council adopted the updated development fees on April 27, 2020, with new fees being implemented on July 13, 2020. During the 2020 updated Development Fee Report, Water and Wastewater Impact Fees were eliminated. The City moved to collect Capacity Fees instead of Development Impact Fees for Water and Wastewater. Although no longer charged, these categories have remaining balances that continue to be tracked separately and utilized for their legally intended purposes.

Development fees are one-time payments used to construct system improvements needed to accommodate new development. The fee represents future development's proportionate share of infrastructure costs. Development fees are charged per dwelling unit for all residential construction. Commercial projects are charged based upon their impact on each service provided and are generally charged on a per square foot basis.

This report includes an unaudited schedule of sources and uses for each type of development fee assessed by the City of Eloy, along with beginning and ending fund balances, interest earnings in each fund for the fiscal year, and the amount of development fee monies spent on each capital improvement project and for each purpose other than a capital improvement project.

Pursuant to ARS, the annual report must contain the following information.

1. The amount assessed by the City for each type of development fee.
2. The balance of each fund maintained for each type of development fee as of the beginning and end of the fiscal year.
3. The amount of interest or other earnings on the monies in each fund as of the end of the fiscal year.

4. The amount of development fees used to repay:
 - a. Bonds issued by the City to pay the cost of a capital improvement project that is subject of a development fee assessment, including the amount needed to repay the debt service obligations on each facility for which development fees have been identified as the source of funding and the time frames in which the debt service will be repaid.
 - b. Monies advanced by the City from funds other than the funds established for development fees in order to pay the cost of a capital improvement project that is the subject of a development fee assessment, the total amount advanced by the City for each facility, the source of the monies advanced and the terms under which the monies will be repaid to the City.
5. The amount of development fee monies spent on each capital improvement project is the subject of a development fee assessment and the physical location of each capital improvement project.
6. The amount of development fee monies spent for each purpose other than a capital improvement project is subject to a development fee assessment.

ARS states that a municipality may assess development fees to offset costs to the municipality associated with providing necessary public services to a development. As of and during the fiscal year ended June 30, 2022, the City of Eloy has assessed and collected development impact fees for the following public services.

- Parks and Recreational Facilities
- Police Facilities
- Streets Facilities

RECOMMENDATION:

Council adopt Resolution No. 22-1537 supporting voter authorization of the 15% Maintenance and Operation Budget Override Election on November 8, 2022, as proposed by the Santa Cruz Valley Union High School District No. 840 Governing Board.

DISCUSSION:

The Santa Cruz Valley Union High School District has called a special budget override election for November 8, 2022, to request voter authorization to exceed the maintenance and operation budget limit by 15% for a period of seven (7) years. The increase authorized by this shall be funded by a levy of taxes on the taxable property within the District.

With voter approval of the override, it is estimated that the total amount of the override for fiscal year 2023-2024 will be \$450,697. The estimated secondary tax rate needed to fund the full override is \$0.32 per \$100 of net assessed valuation for secondary tax purposes. The estimated cost for an owner of a home with a limited property value of \$86,629 (the average value of a home in the District) would be approximately \$28 per year.

The 15% Maintenance and Operation Budget Override would continue funding for programs currently serving District students. This override supports the District's efforts to help maintain present levels of service for the following:

- Increase athletic funding for sports to provide coaches, uniforms, equipment and supplies;
- Attract and retain highly qualified teachers by maintaining competitive teacher salaries and benefits;
- Reduce class sizes;

- Maintain and add additional elective classes for students, such as band, music, art, and culinary arts;
- Maintain a safe and orderly environment by providing funding for safety

Quality educational programs and facilities are important to the City of Eloy in its efforts to recruit new and expand existing businesses and industries, which create job opportunities for students graduating from Santa Cruz Valley Union High School.

Staff recommends Council adopt a resolution encouraging residents to support this bond override election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and City Council of the City of Eloy, Arizona, endorses the 15% Maintenance and Operation Budget Override proposed by the Santa Cruz Valley Union High School District, and encourages voters to approve this budget override on November 8, 2022.
