DISCUSSION:

This work session will exclusively center on receiving presentations from the eight (8) community agencies recommended for funding via the City of Eloy Community Outreach Program. The two entities not recommended have been notified that they may address the Mayor and Council during the comment segment of the regular meeting concerning approving the funding limit for the Community Outreach Program.

This year, the City received twelve applications totaling \$131,125. Eight of the twelve applications were from the prior year, and four were new applications. The total amount recommended by the review panel for FY 2024-2025 is \$108,500.

The regular council session packet includes all applications from each agency and all documentation pertaining to the Community Outreach Program for reference.
